

Abstract

An abstract should be on the page immediately following the title page.

Center title: Abstract.

Double-space, using same font and margins as essay.

Do not number the page (or the title page). Begin pagination (page 1) with the essay.

The abstract should be one paragraph, approximately 150-200 words in length.

Write the abstract *after* completing the paper so that you know the paper's thesis and supporting arguments. Be sure to include more than paper's topic; provide your argument.

Do not write in future tense, e.g., "The paper will show that"

The paper is completed: it does certain things, not will do them.

Do not use first person, e.g., "I argue that . . ." or "My paper shows that"
